Study Abroad Participation for Non-UNT Students

All participants in UNT study abroad programs must be enrolled UNT students. In addition to signing up with and paying program costs to the UNT Study Abroad Center, non-UNT students must apply for admission to the University. There are no exceptions.

- ❑ Non-UNT students who wish to attend UNT **short term study abroad programs (Faculty-Led programs)** *MUST* apply, and be accepted, for Transient (winter) or Summer Visitor (summer) status at UNT. Such students often come to UNT for the abroad term only.

OR

- ❑ Non-UNT students who wish to attend **long term study abroad programs through UNT** *MUST* apply and be accepted to UNT and complete a semester or summer semester term of classes at UNT before their proposed study abroad term.

UNT applicants will be notified of their status (acceptance) by letter approximately one week after their application is received. As soon as student is notified of acceptance, he or she should contact the SAC (940-565-2207). Students will be responsible to register for classes and pay their tuition and fees for the program course(s); instructions for these processes will be provided by the SAC as part of the program orientation. It will be the student's responsibility to register and pay for the courses in a timely manner.

Base Tuition and Fee Rates

Texas resident, undergraduate tuition for 6 credit hours is approximately \$991.00. Non-resident, undergraduate tuition for 6 credit hours is \$2407.00.

Texas resident graduate tuition for 6 credit hours is approximately \$1267.00. Non-resident graduate tuition for 6 credit hours is \$2683.00.

*Base rates do not include course fees, and are subject to change.
